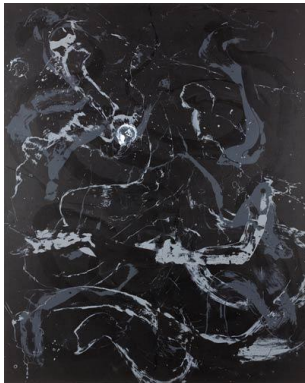

3 Corner Symphony Art Exhibition at Skyline College



San Bruno, California – September 12, 2011 – *3 Corner Symphony*, a group exhibit featuring paintings, sculpture and mixed media works by Oakland-based artist Gregory Wiley Edwards, Boston-based artist Fay Grajower and Calgary-based artist Malcolm Mooney will run from September 15 – October 21, 2011. An opening reception will be held on Thursday, September 15, from 5:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. at Skyline College's Gallery. A live musical performance by Malcolm Mooney and the 10th Planet will follow the reception at 8:30 p.m. in the gallery.

3 Corner Symphony refers to the three points on a map that form a triangle between the artist's studios, with a visual symphony developing in the gallery via the combination of and intersection of the visual "sounds" that the artists present.
