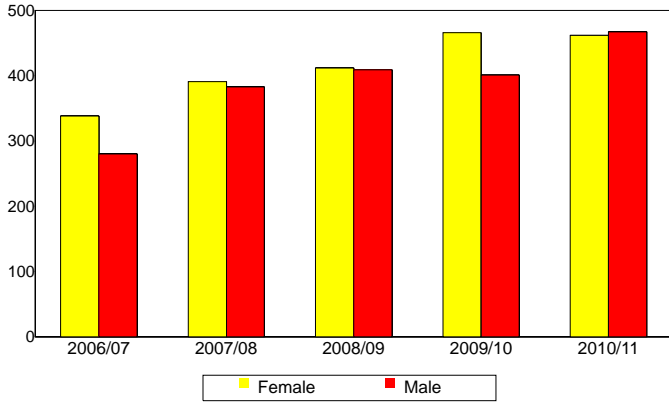

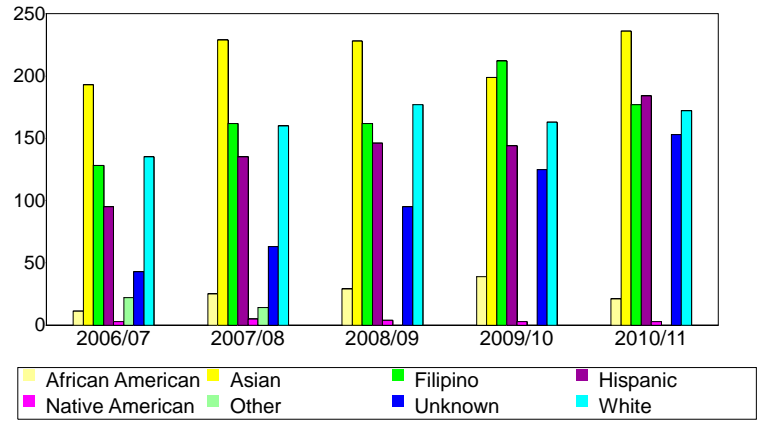

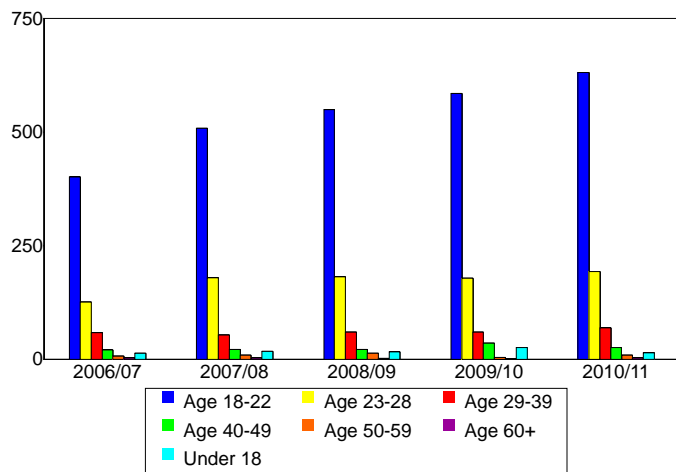
Unique Headcount by Gender



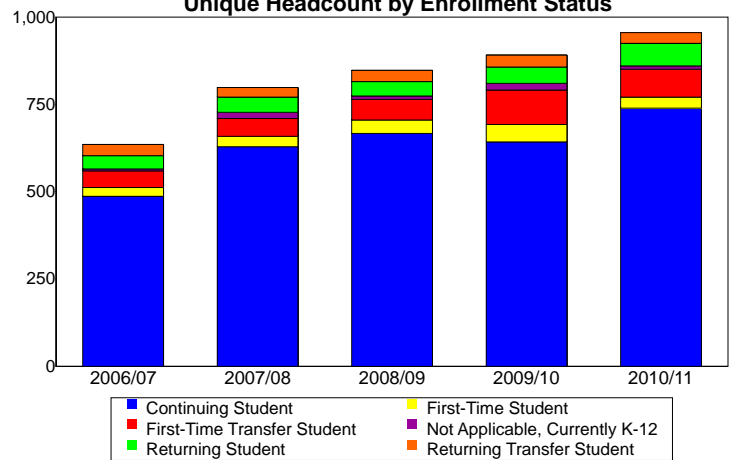
Unique Headcount by Ethnicity



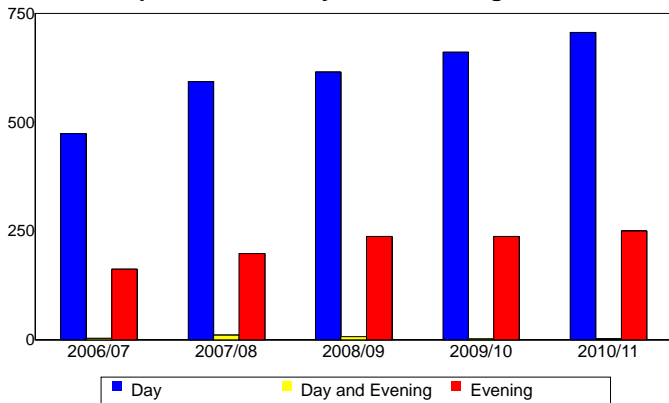
Unique Headcount by Student Age



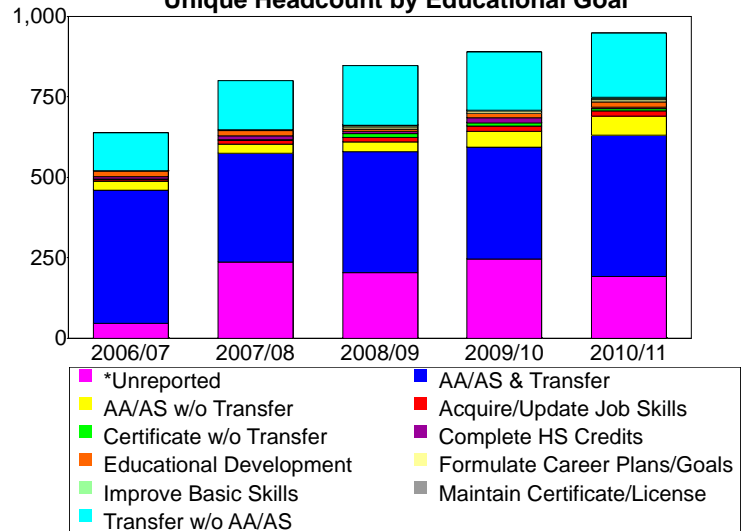
Unique Headcount by Enrollment Status
