## UC DAVIS FALL 2011 TAG PROGRAM

### MINIMUM UC ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- 2 courses of UC transferable English composition
- 1 course of UC transferable Math or Mathematical statistics
- 4 additional courses chosen from at least two of the following subject areas: Arts and Humanities; Social and Behavior Sciences; and Physical and Biological Sciences

**SELECTIVE MAJORS BELOW** – The minimum GPA and course requirements listed below are required for admission. They must be completed by the end of Spring 2011 semester. For additional course work in your major, see [www.assist.org](http://www.assist.org)

**NON-SELECTIVE MAJORS** – For majors not listed below, see [www.assist.org](http://www.assist.org) for lower division major coursework. For all majors, both selective and non-selective, the minimum GPA is required at the time the TAG is written and must be maintained in all transfer work with no grade less than “C.”

- **BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES, COLLEGE OF:** 2.9 overall UC transferable GPA and 2.5 GPA in each group of courses with no grade less than “C”: MATH 241 & 242 OR MATH 251 & 252; CHEM 210 & 220; BIOL 215 & 230. Strongly recommended: CHEM 234/237 and 235/238.
- **BIOTECHNOLOGY:** 2.8 overall UC transferable GPA and 2.5 in each group of courses with no grade less than “C”:. MATH 241 & 242 OR MATH 251 & 252; CHEM 210 & 220; BIOL 215 & 230. Strongly recommended: CHEM 234/237 & 235/238.
- **COMMUNICATION:** 2.9 overall UC transferable GPA and 3.0 in the following group of courses with no grade less than “C”: PSYC 100; SOC 100; MATH 200. Must have 3.0 for group of courses that have been completed when the TAG is written. Additional major prerequisite courses will be required after transfer.
- **ENGINEERING, COLLEGE OF:** 3.1 UC transferable GPA. Must complete all lower division engineering courses required for admission by the end of Spring 2011 semester. All courses must be completed with a grade of “C” or better (See [www.assist.org](http://www.assist.org) and [engineering.ucdavis.edu](http://engineering.ucdavis.edu)).
- **INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS:** 2.9 overall UC transferable GPA and 3.0 in the following group of courses with no grade less than “C”: ECON 100, ECON 102 or ANTH 110; POLI 130, MATH 200. Must have 3.0 for the group of courses that have been completed when the TAG is written. Additional major prerequisite courses will be required after transfer.
- **PRE-LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE:** 2.8 overall UC transferable GPA, be willing to arrange TAG for “Pre-Landscape Architecture” and apply in the Landscape Architecture (Pre-) category of the UC application. A portfolio must be submitted in February before or after enrollment at UC Davis. Contact (530) 754-8628 or visit [ida.ucdavis.edu](http://ida.ucdavis.edu) for portfolio details. TAG does not guarantee admission to the major.
- **PRE-MANAGERIAL ECONOMICS:** 2.8 overall UC transferable GPA. TAG does not guarantee admission to major. Apply in the “Managerial Economics (Pre-)” category of the UC application. After first quarter at Davis, a petition for admission may be submitted. Must receive a letter grade in each course and only the first repeat of any pre-major course is considered for petition review. For admission to the Managerial Economics major, must complete the following courses with at least a 2.8 GPA: ECON 100, ECON 102; MATH 200; MATH 241 & 242 OR MATH 251 & 252.
- **PSYCHOLOGY:** 2.9 overall UC transferable GPA and 2.9 GPA in the following courses with no grade less than “C”: PSYC 100; PSYC 105; MATH 200; BIOL 230 OR the combination of BIOL 110 or BIOL 101 plus ANTH 125 or BIOL 130 or BIOL 260; one course in Sociology or Cultural Anthropology (ANTH 110). Must have 2.9 for the group of courses that have been completed when the TAG is written.
- **VITICULTURE & ENOLOGY:** 2.8 overall UC transferable GPA and 3.0 in the following group of courses with no grade less than “C”: CHEM 210 & 220; CHEM 234 (recommend completion of CHEM 237 as well); MATH 241 or 251; PHYS 210/211 & 220/221, BIOL 230. Strongly recommended: MATH 242 or 252; CHEM 235 & 238; BIO 215 (pre-requisite to BIO 230); if taken, must have 3.0 GPA with no grade less than C.
