**GPA Requirements for the College of Letters and Science:**

- Earn an overall minimum 3.20 GPA in all UC transferable course work by the end of Fall 2010 semester
- Earn a minimum 2.0 GPA in all UC transferable coursework in the Fall 2010 semester
- Maintain a minimum overall 3.20 GPA through the end of the Spring 2011 semester
- Earn a minimum 2.0 GPA in all UC transferable coursework in the Spring 2011 semester.

**College of Engineering TAG**

- The following majors require completion of specific major preparatory coursework: Computer Engineering (B.S.), Computer Science (B.S.), Electrical Engineering (B.S.), and Mechanical Engineering (B.S.).
- ***TAG does not apply to the major of Chemical Engineering (B.S.)***
- Complete all required base preparation courses for the intended major by the end of the Spring 2011 semester
- Applicants must also complete two advanced preparation course offered at their community college.

- Students may attend more than one California community college to earn credit for the required major preparation courses if the courses are not offered or if their schedule constrains them from completing major preparation courses at their own campus.

**GPA requirements for the College of Engineering TAG:**

Earn an overall minimum 3.20 GPA in all UC transferable coursework by the end of Fall 2010 semester

Earn a minimum 2.0 GPA in all UC transferable coursework in the Fall 2010 semester

Earn an overall minimum 3.20 GPA in all major preparatory coursework by the end of Fall 2010 semester

Maintain an overall minimum 3.20 GPA in all major preparatory coursework through the end of the Spring 2011 semester

Earn a minimum 2.0 GPA in all UC transferable coursework in the Spring 2011 semester
