

# Debriefing Forum

It will be an opportunity for students, faculty and staff to get an information update, ask questions and provide feedback on how our handling of the incident went. Chief Telford of the San Bruno Police Department will attend.

## **Aftermath of the Wednesday, September 2 shooting incident**

The police believe that the 1:30 p.m. shooting on campus Wednesday afternoon resulted from a confrontation between two groups and that this was not a random incident (that is, the people involved knew each other and the shooting was connected to their relationship, not to the college). One individual was sent to the hospital with a non-life threatening gunshot wound, and later released. The investigation is continuing and there are other suspects being sought.

The campus quickly went into lockdown in order to protect the safety of students and staff, and the police went through the building-by-building process of clearing the offices and classrooms and escorting people off campus. The police were able to evacuate everyone safely and there were no further injuries after the initial incident. They were assisted by police from 19 agencies, along with our own Public Safety officers from across the district. The college utilized a number of means to communicate with everyone: our public address system, emergency text messaging, emails to students and staff, and messages on the front page of our website.

## **Here are a few key points of information about what will be happening on campus:**

- There will be **additional police and Public Safety presence** on campus into next week, with additional escort service to parking lots in the evenings.
- **Counseling is available to students** in the Student & Community Center (Bldg.6) in the study area on the second floor and in the Student Services Center in Building 2 from:

Friday, September 4 from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm  
Tuesday, September 8 from 8:00 am to 7:00 pm  
Wednesday, September 9 from 8:00 am to 7:00 pm

**Individual counseling** is also available. Students can call 4318 to make an appointment with a counselor.
